

NORTH VALLEY ACADEMY DRESS CODE POLICY

There will be no exceptions to the dress code policy. The school uniform' is an integral part of our campus climate, discipline, safety and community-building. Students are expected to arrive and remain in uniform while on campus and/or at school sponsored events such as field trips and assemblies.

The School Uniform - Maroon top with khaki bottoms.

Jackets

- * No professional team logos are permitted on any jackets or other outerwear.

Sweaters and sweatshirts

- * When worn in classrooms, all sweaters and sweatshirts must be solid white or maroon. ,

Shirts

- * Collared, button down, or polo style, long or short sleeved.
- * Well-fitted (not too large or too small).
- * Turtlenecks and undershirts are allowed as long as they are solid maroon or white.
- * Top shirt must be solid in color and not see through .
- * No crop tops, middriff, tube tops or shirts that show any part of the stomach or waist.

Bottoms

- * Khaki - this refers to cotton twill material. No jeans or denim material.
- * No overalls or coveralls.
- * Pants must be hemmed. No frayed bottoms or dragging on the ground.
- * Well-fitted.
- * No baggies or skater-style bell-bottoms.

Boy's Attire

- * Long pants or mid-length shorts.
- * No pants or shorts worn below the waistline.

Girl's Attire

- * Long pants, Capris, mid-length skirts, shorts, or jumpers. All hemlines must be at least as long as where the middle finger touches when hands are held down to the sides.
- * All girls, K - 3, must wear shorts underneath dresses or jumpers.

Hair

- * Hair will not be dyed colors that are not natural (pink, orange, blue, green, purple, etc.)
- * No temporary hair coloring or gels.
- * No excessive hairdos, i.e. -loose dreadlocks, Mohawks, "big hair", or excessively spiked hair.

Make-up

- * Only natural looking makeup is permitted. No black/excessively dark or neon colored eye shadow, lipstick and/or nail color.
- * Student may be asked to remove makeup per teacher/staff discretion.

Shoes

- * Street sole shoes must be worn at all times.
- * No pool shoes or slippers.

Additional Dress Code Guidelines

- * No baggy or oversized uniforms.
- * No undergarments may show.
- * No pants or shorts worn below the waistline. No excessively low hip huggers.
- * No hats or sunglasses.
- * Uniforms may not be rolled.
- * Bandanas are not permitted.
- * Any group-identifying accessories are prohibited.
- * Belts will not be excessively long.
- * No body-piercing jewelry except for earrings.
- * Jewelry will not be dangerous, disruptive, or distracting.
- * Students are permitted to change into appropriate sports clothing for school events only after the regular school day has ended.

Teachers and staff will refer questionable clothing styles to the administration for final determination of appropriateness for school. Failure to comply will result in the student being required to change the non-compliant garment(s) and/or accessories. Repeated violations will result in further corrective action.
